### **Message from the Governors**


I'm hoping this is the last time I have to mention the Pandemic in a newsletter!

I hope you all enjoy the half term break.



A year on from our first national lockdown, we understand that many families may be facing financial difficulty, either due to historic debts or that they may be accumulating debts.

Understanding that this is a continued area of concern in our local community, we would like to remind you of the **free debt advice** we offer - supported by Community Money Advice, as well as being authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA).

Enfield Debt Centre is run in conjunction with North Enfield Foodbank. The centre is conveniently located at the same premises as our Foodbank, at Jubilee Central, 2 Lumina Way, Enfield EN1 1FS.

Open on **Tuesdays**, **Thursdays** and **Saturdays** from **11am-3pm** (the same times as our Foodbank), the centre offers support and advice, helping people to arrange payment plans with creditors and to manage their personal finances through budgeting. People can also be signposted to relevant organisations.

The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and the Metropolitan Police Service. This project is known as Operation Encompass.

Operation Encompass is the notification to schools that a child (under 18) has been exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident. This will ordinarily be done by the start of the next school day.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a specially trained member of the school staff, known as a Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL), is informed. The DSL can then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to ensure the wellbeing of the child.

The school may be able to make provisions or adjustments to assist the child and their family.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.

## BREXIT INFORMATION FOR EU PARENTS



Have you applied for settled/pre-settled status to secure your rights in the UK after 30 June 2021? What about your children, recently born babies?

#### REMEMBER:

If you recently had a baby, you need to get in touch with your Embassy/Consulate and apply for their passport. You must have a valid photo ID to apply for settled/pre-settled status for your child.

## THE IMPACT OF BREXIT ON EU PARENTS

Brexit will affect the lives of EU citizens and their children. Parents, legal guardians and those with any responsibility for a child/children may need to take action to ensure they secure the rights of those children in the UK. According to The Migration Observatory, there are over 900,000 children of non-Irish EU citizens living in the UK.

In many cases, parents, carers or legal guardians may not know that these children can and need to apply.

This includes 239,000 children born in the UK, many of whom may not be British citizens.
