THE MARTIN HERAUD JUNIOR AWARDS FOR ACHIEVEMENT—SUMMER 2022

Martin Heraud was born in Enfield in 1938. Martin was a member of Edmonton Rotary Club and then transferred to Bush Hill Park Rotary Club until his untimely death in 1984 at the age of 46. It was always his wish that particular attention should be given to supporting local charities and local needs. One of his greatest attributes was his perseverance and sense of endeavour, and it is with this in mind that the Rotary Club of Bush Hill Park has provided the Martin Heraud Awards to be made to those pupils whose achievement reflects these characteristics. The Martin Heraud Memorial Prize is awarded annually by the Rotary Club of Bush Hill Park to two pupils, one boy and one girl, who have have achieved the greatest progress during the course of the school year.



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ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

At Bush Hill Park Primary we actively encourage your child to attend school every day. We reward good attendance by:

- Class rewards if your class has the highest weekly attendance they will receive a class certificate during the weekly school assembly.
- 100% attendance at the end of every term we award the children who have had 100% attendance with a certificate and rewards. If children have complete perfection and reached the end of the academic year with 100% attendance they receive a larger gift.
- **Termly Attendance weeks** Children are awarded with certificates, stickers, pencils and parties. Photos on website and Twitter.

If your child is absent from school you, as the parent/carer, must phone the office on 0208 366 0521 by 9.30am to explain why your child is not in school. You can also leave a message on the absent line. This will then be recorded as an authorised or unauthorised absence.

Authorised Absence:

This is when the school authorises an absence because they agree that the reason is acceptable, for example:

- Illness severe enough to prevent the child coming to school
- Exceptional family circumstances
- Part of the day being missed for an essential medical appointment routine check-ups should not be done in school time.

Unauthorised Absence:

This is when the school has not allowed the absences because the reason is not acceptable, for example:

- Taking a whole day off school for a medical appointment
- Minor illnesses or very frequent absence due to minor illness unless backed up with a medical note
- Holidays
- Birthdays or day trips
- Being tired
- Shopping

Attendance Matters



Persistent Absentee – IMPORTANT:

Children are defined as persistent absentees by the Department for Education (DFE) if their attendance falls below 90%. This is for any absence whether authorised or unauthorised. The DFE expects schools to intervene well before pupils reach a level of persistent absence. At Bush Hill Park Primary we carefully monitor all children's attendance. If we see it going towards or below 90% our Educational Welfare Officer (EWO) will intervene. Whilst we will always try to resolve the situation with the family within school, if a resolution cannot be achieved to improve the child's attendance and where unauthorised absence persists the EWO will be required to consider the instigation of legal proceedings which include; Penalty Notices, Parental Prosecution and Education Supervision Orders.



CONGRATULATIONS to Year 2 who consistently won our Weekly Attendance prize, with Marigold Class being the overall winners this year. Very well done to them.

It has been tough for all with Covid and chickenpox sweeping through the classes and disrupting the children's learning, with our whole school attendance finishing on 94%. Well done everyone!



ENFIELD CATERING SERVICES

With effect from 5th September 2022, the cost of a school dinner will increase by 9 pence a day from £2.37 (£11.85 per week) to £2.46 per day (£12.30 per week)

We do our best to support our school community, but due to reduced funding and the need to reduce the cost to the school, the increase was agreed by Governors on Wednesday 6th July 2022, so the provision can continue to be sustainable

School dinners should be paid at least a week in advance using Parent Pay.

The total cost for the first half of the Autumn term is £86.10.

A year on from our first national lockdown, we understand that many families may be facing financial difficulty, either due to historic debts or that they may be accumulating debts.

Understanding that this is a continued area of concern in our local community, we would like to remind you of the **free debt advice** we offer - supported by Community Money Advice, as well as being authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA).

Enfield Debt Centre is run in conjunction with North Enfield Foodbank. The centre is conveniently located at the same premises as our Foodbank, at **Jubilee Central**, **2 Lumina Way**, **Enfield EN1 1FS**.

Open on **Tuesdays**, **Thursdays** and **Saturdays** from **11am-3pm** (the same times as our Foodbank), the centre offers support and advice, helping people to arrange payment plans with creditors and to manage their personal finances through budgeting. People can also be signposted to relevant organisations.
