

 5-year-olds who aren't read to at home attain less in Year 6 assessments









Graphemes

A grapheme is a sound written down

English has more than 150 ways of writing the 44 sounds using our 26 letters(groups of letters as well as single letters)

We teach the 100 most commonly used graphemes systematically and thoroughly.

(Fred can only say c_a_t, he can't say cat)

We call this Fred Talk(you could use a toy to do this).

- they can blend orally

Blending is needed for reading

Fred helps children learn to spell too!

Children convert words into sounds

They press the sounds on to their fingers...

We call this Fred Fingers
