Starting School

- 2 sessions – morning or afternoon
 - 30 children each session
 - Play and stay – 4th July
 - Home visit
 - Morning 8.40am – 11.40am
 - Afternoon 12.30pm – 3.30pm



30 Free hours

- We have 10 spaces for children eligible for 30 free hours.
- 9 to 3, however we have a soft start from 8.40 and the Nursery is open until 3.30pm
- Children will not begin the full day until Monday 24th September



Staggered Entry

- Entry will be staggered
- ½ of the children will be in: Monday 17th September, Wednesday 19th September with parent
- ½ of the children will be in: Tuesday 18th September, Thursday 20th September with parent
- All children will be in Friday 21st September with parent
- If child is settled they will be in full time the following week
- Please check your timings in your packs!

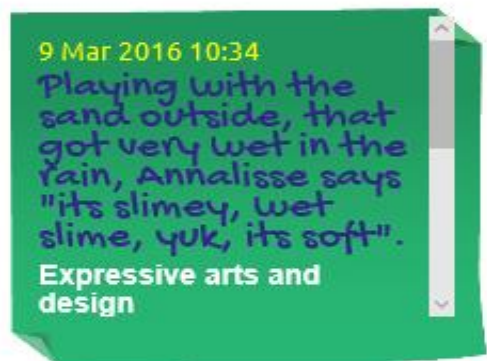
