



HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT (COVID-19)

The school will do its best to:

- Encourage children to take care of each other and of their environment.
- Encourage children to work hard to reach their full potential during these difficult times.
- Provide a supportive environment in which all children can feel safe, secure and part of a community.
- Provide a supportive range of appropriate remote and class-based learning.
- Inform parents of any changes to school hours, days or times.
- Inform parents if a member of staff or pupil tests positive to COVID-19 and provide guidance as required.
- Provide opportunities for parents to contact their child's class teacher by email or by phone on request at a mutually acceptable time.
- Respond to parents' concerns in accordance with school policy.
- Reduce the sharing of equipment between pupils with individual labelled trays.
- Maintain a 2-metre social distance as far as is possible with young children.
- Regularly clean touched surfaces, equipment, furniture and toilets.
- Keep pupils within 'bubbles' to reduce potential contact with other pupils and staff.

As a Parent/Carer I will do my best to:

- Ensure that my child attends school and arrives on time, in accordance with the new 'bubble' timetables, staggered breaks/lunch times, and is collected on time at the end of the new school day.
- Provide my child with clean clothes every school day.
- Stay in touch with the class teacher to discuss homework and my child's progress.
- Support the school by responding to emails and letters.
- Support my child with their homework and other opportunities for home learning and challenges on Twitter @Bushhillschool
- Support the school's Behaviour Policy and any addendums in light of COVID-19.
- Inform the school of any issue (such as bereavement, anxiety or family illness) which may affect the behaviour or achievement of my child.
- Behave appropriately on the school premises, with pupils, staff and other parents in line with the school's Visitor Protocol.
- Keep my child at home if they are feeling unwell with symptoms of coronavirus (new persistent dry cough or high temperature of 37.8).
- Keep my child at home for 14 days if a member of my household has symptoms of coronavirus.
- Collect my child as soon as possible if the school notifies me they are unwell.
- Update the school with my emergency contacts and my email and address if these change.
- Monitor the health of my child/children, such as checking their temperature.
- Keep to UK Government COVID-19 guidelines at all times so I do not risk the health of the school community.
- Send my child/children to school with a hat, water bottle and sun-cream applied on hot days.
- Send my child/children to school with a healthy packed-lunch if they are in KS2.
- Keep school rules, including NOT sending my child/children to school wearing gloves, as these are not permitted because they pose a risk of spreading germs to themselves and others. Washing hands with soap and water regularly is best.
- Nominate ONLY ONE PARENT/CARER to pick up and drop off my child/children during the given times and vacate the school site immediately, to minimise the number of adults on site.
- Abide by the 2-metre social distancing and follow the markings on the floor, walls or fencing in and around the school site, making sure not to gather at entrance gates or doors.
- Follow safety instructions from staff politely, timely and safely.
- Contact the school by email or phone and if it is essential to visit the School Office, to call first to ask for an appointment.

- Report my child's absence by calling the School Office each day that they should be attending.

As a pupil I will do my best to:

- Behave respectfully (this means being friendly, helpful and kind in what I say or do, as well as following the School Rules).
- Take care of what I own, what other people own and what the school owns.
- Work hard for personal achievement and home and in school.
- Use appropriate language (this means no name-calling, swearing, hurtful or racist comments).
- Take pride in my work at school and at home.
- Stay left and navigate corridors in a clockwise direction.
- Only use the areas in school that I'm allowed to and instructed to use.
- Wash my hands regularly, for at least 20 seconds throughout the day, and after using the toilet, before eating and after returning from breaktime or lunchtime play, and sanitise my hands when asked to do so.
- Only mix with other pupils from within my bubble or group.
- Keep within the boundaries of the area staff say I can play in when outside and inside school.
- Wash or sanitise my hands after coughing or sneezing into a tissue or my elbow.
- Place any tissues I use in a dustbin straight away after using it and washing my hands.
- Only use the utensils and learning resources which have been provided for me.
- Not touch my mouth, eyes and nose.
- Wait my turn to use the toilet one person at a time.
