We have a limited number of books available to purchase on the day for £3!



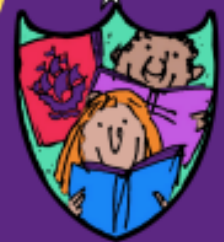
Celebrate World BOOK DAY
