Free Breakfast

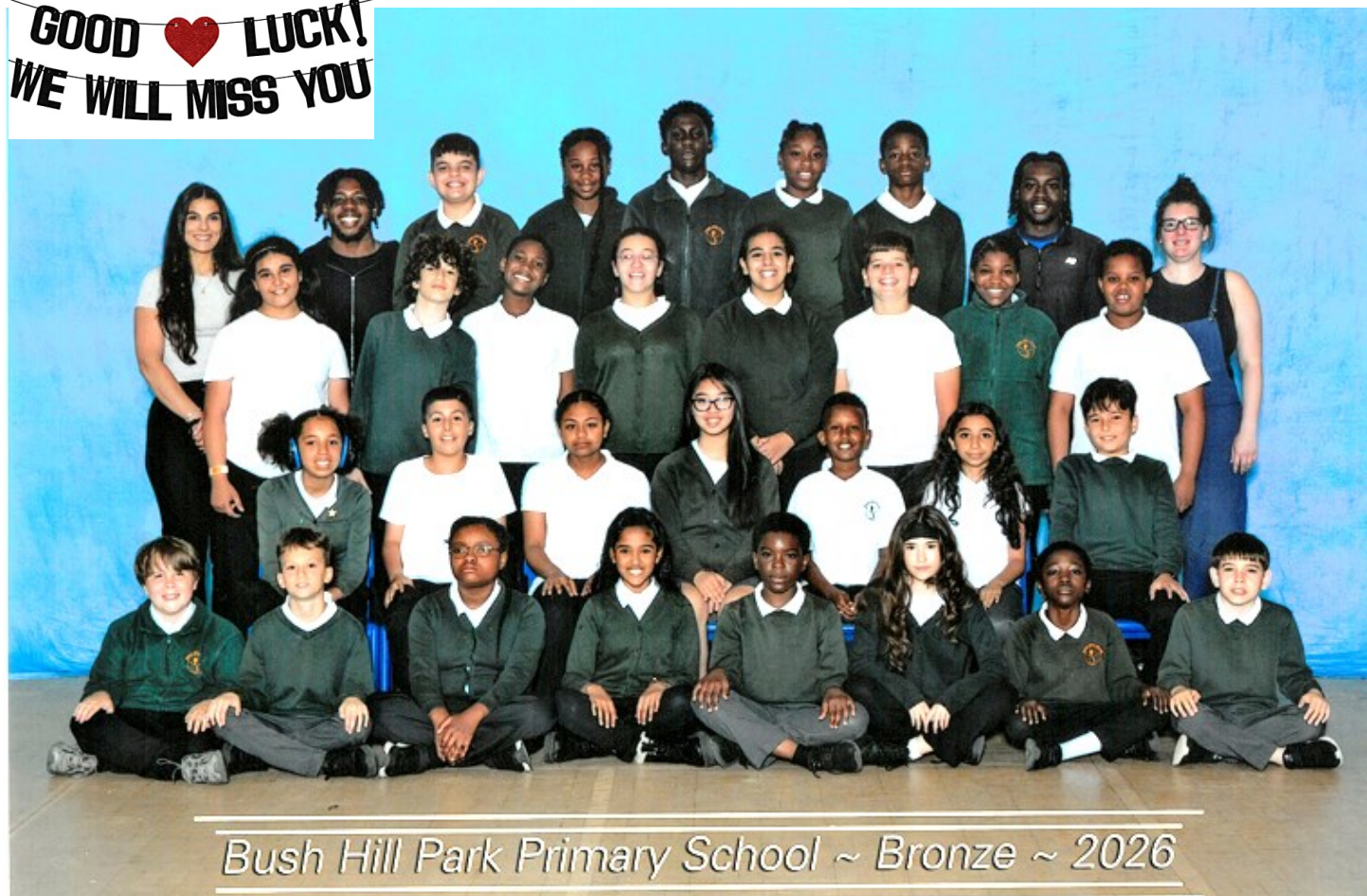

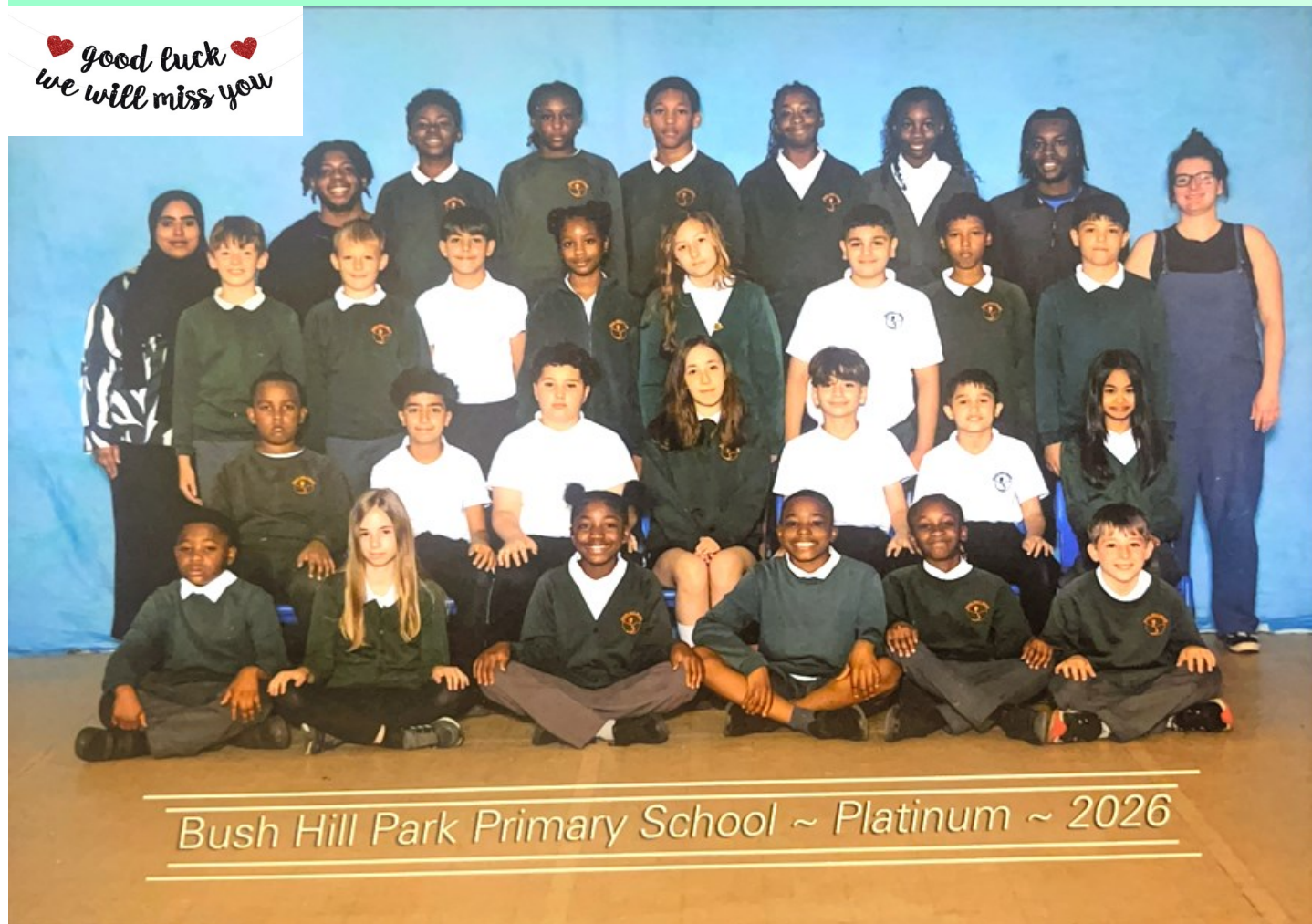

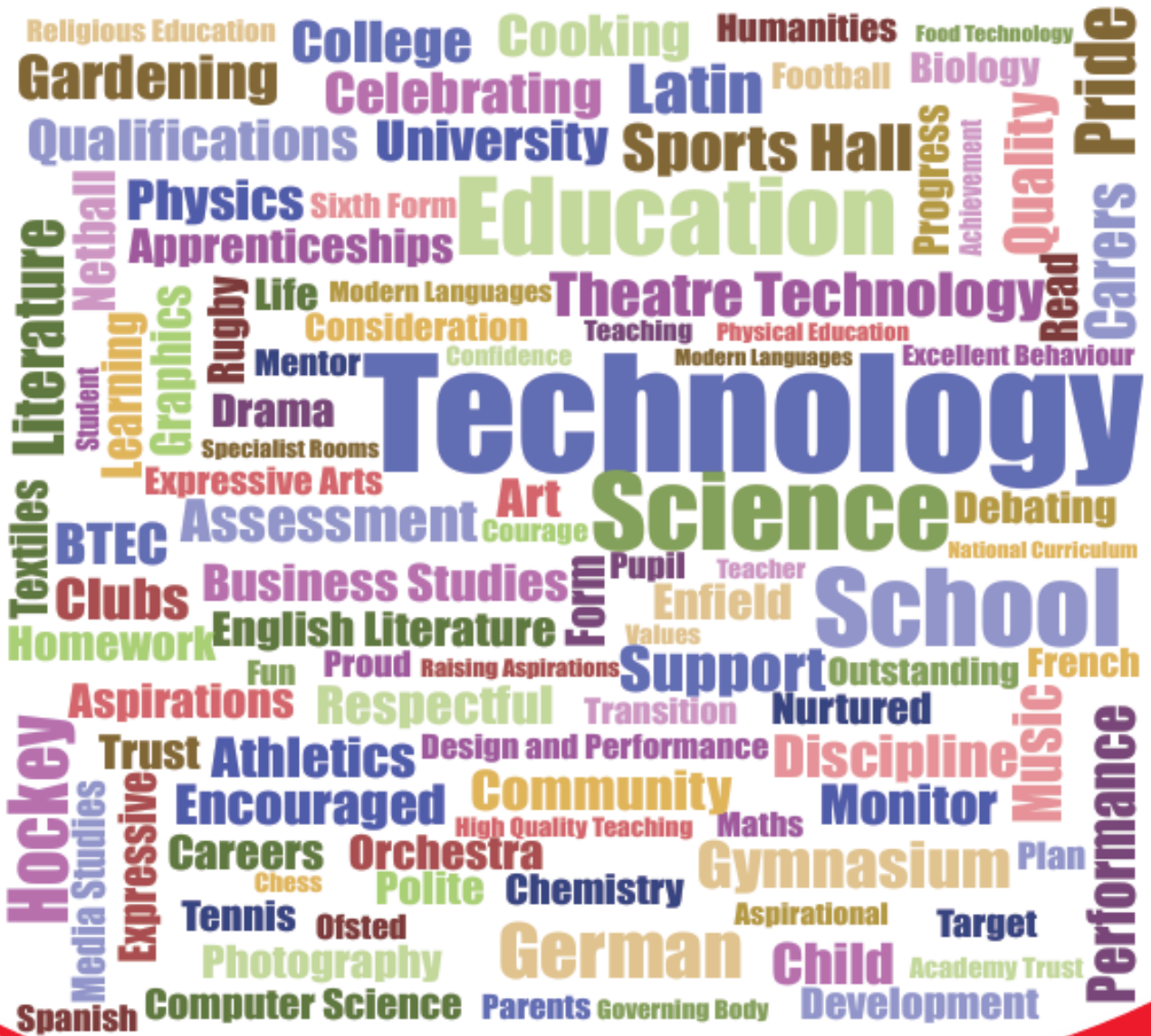
